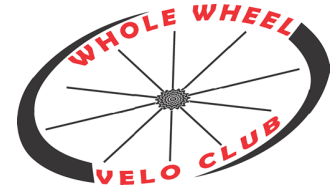

EVENT HELD UNDER USA CYCLING PERMIT

Register online at www.bikereg.com or in-person on race day. Day-of registration opens at 7:00 am and closes 30 minutes prior to each event. Entry fee \$35 (not including the additional fee charged by Bike Reg).

All entrants must have a USA Cycling annual road license. No 1-day licenses will be sold.

Riders under 18 must have a parent's signature. MABRA and Virginia Championship Races run together and scored separately.

Eligibility for the Virginia or MABRA championship will be determined by the rider's address in the USA Cycling database on race day.
