Schedule of Events

Gatewood Park Time Trial, Friday, May 7

37°02'41.23"N 80°52'11.65"W

Ten mile rolling course starting at Gatewood Park traveling west on Gatewood Park Rd with a turn-around point located approximately ¼ mile prior to the intersection with Rt. 710. First rider start time at 5:30 p.m. **Riders MUST preregister for this event.** There will be no registration the day of the event. Categories: M40/50/60+ (1-4), M/W Jr. 10-18, M30+, M1/2/3, M Cat3/4, M Cat 5, W 1-4/40

Randolph Park Criterium #1, Saturday, May 8

37°5'23.21"N 80°41'53.22"W

The race will travel clockwise around a flat circular perimeter road with start/finish line to be located on the straight stretch near the lower parking lot.

Omnium Rules & Fees

Points

Riders who sign up for points omnium (and any additional category omniums) qualify for payout. **There will not be a payout for individual races.** Top 7 places in each race receive points for each event:

Place	1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th	5 th	6 th	7 th
Points	7	6	5	4	3	2	1

Total points accumulated in all three races will determine a rider's position for the omnium payout. Medals only for top three omnium winners in category 5 and juniors.

Omnium Entry Fees

\$70 for Men 30+, Men 40/50/60+, M 3/4, Men 1-3, W 1-4/40+

\$60 for Men Cat 5

\$30 for Juniors

\$50 to enter additional omnium (Men 30+, Men 40/50/60+, M 3/4, Men 1-3, W 1-4/40+)

Additional Omnium = \$50 (may only register day of event if room is available)

Payout

Men 1-3: \$900 cash or 50% of entry fees

1st: \$200, 2nd: \$175, 3rd: \$150, 4th: \$125, 5th: \$100, 6th: \$75, 7th: \$50, 8th: \$25

Women 1-4/40+: \$325 or 50% of entry fees

1st: \$150, 2nd: \$100, 3rd: \$50, 4th: \$25

Men 3/4: \$550 or 50% of entry fees

1st: \$150, 2nd: \$125, 3rd: \$100, 4th: \$75, 5th: \$50, 6th: \$50

Men 30+: \$550 or 50% of entry fees

1st: \$150, 2nd: \$125, 3rd: \$100, 4th: \$75, 5th: \$50, 6th: \$50,

Men 40/50/60+: \$325 or 50% of entry fees

1st: \$150, 2nd: \$100, 3rd: \$50, 4th: \$25

Directions

Gatewood Park (Friday TT)

I-81 exit 94 to route 99 north, continue through town of Pulaski (Rt. 99 will become Third Street). Turn left at Randolph Avenue and one block, turn right on West Main Street, go 3 blocks, turn right on Magazine Street, go one block, turn left on Mt. Olivet Road (710). Travel 2.3 miles, take right onto Gatewood Park Rd.

Randolph Park (Sat & Sun Crit)

I-81 exit 98 to route 100 north towards Dublin. Left at first stop light onto Alexander Road. Park is one mile on the right.

Registration

Register at www.bikereg.com by 11:59 p.m., May 5. Use USAC 2010 standard release form. Riders under 18 require parent's signature to race. VACA BAR winners will sign up under BAR Winners on BikeReg.

\$3 USAC and \$1 VACA BAR are included in all posted entry fees

Entry fee includes \$3 USAC and \$1 VACA fees. 2009 BAR Winners eligible for one free entry but must pay the USAC and VCA fees. All USAC rules apply. Each racer must present a valid USAC license. One-day license (Cat5 men and Cat4 women only, \$10 cash or check) will be available for purchase at time of packet pickup. Promoter reserves the right to cancel or combine events if there are less than 10 riders in an event. Races held rain or shine. Start time are approximate but no race will start ahead of its scheduled time.
