

Bryan Park Training Series

Location: Azalea garden area of Bryan Park Richmond, VA. (Google Bryan Park for directions)

Dates: Tuesday Evenings May 19th through September 8^h, 2015

Race Times:

B race (Cat 4/5) 6 PM

A race (Cat 1, 2, 3) 10 min after B race or approximately 6:45 PM

* No official BP training race on date for Working Man's Classic stage race *

Course: 0.8 mile loop. Race distances vary on daylight throughout the summer, but approximately 12 and 18 miles for B and A respectively.

Field Limit: 75 per race

Registration: USAC Pre-Registration & on-site only beginning at 5:30 PM

Entry Fee:

\$15 per race with USAC license

\$30 per race without a USAC license (Includes \$15 USAC one day Competitive License)

One Day Competitive Licenses ONLY available to CAT 5 men, CAT 4 women & Juniors

\$155 season pass with USAC license (not inclusive of WMC event)

Prizes: 3 deep in A and B

A \$25, 15, 10

B \$15, 10, 5

Weather policy: We will not race if the pavement is wet. We will post announcements on our FB page & Twitter feed as well as the VaCycling listserv as soon as practicable.

Despite the significant cost increases by USAC to permit and insure races, we have kept the season pass cost at BP below \$10 per race. We also have more races.. The season pass is still the cheapest thrill this side of an alleycat race. This pass is for the full 16 race series and works out to less than \$10 per race including the \$3.60 USAC fee. Racing will be every Tuesday this summer weather permitting.

Note - this pass is not valid for the Working Man's Classic

Also note that there is no pre-registration for individual races. Individual race entries are \$15 and will be day of registration at the course. One day licenses will be available for \$15.
